Dear members and friends,

Our second Lady Day service will be at the Cathedral in Bunbury on Tuesday 25th March. Planning for both services is now underway and further details will be available shortly.

As mentioned in my last newsletter our 2025 Friendship Day will be held in Boyanup on Friday 11th July. Executive will confirm arrangements at its March meeting Our 2025 Country Rally will be hosted by Mandurah branch on Thursday 16th October. The branch has planning for this day in hand and will share details a little closer to the time.

We are now in a position to move forward with the making of our new diocesan banner which will hang in the Cathedral once completed. The Dean will be applying for a faculty to have our old banner hung in a permanent location within the cathedral in a glass display case, which we will commission as soon as we have received advice that the faculty has been approved.

On a state level, I will be meeting with my Perth and NWA counterparts next month to continue discussions regarding plans for a statewide gathering in 2026 to mark the 150th anniversary of the formation of Mothers' Union by Mary Sumner. On a national level I will be participating in a Zoom meeting with other Australian diocesan presidents on 14th January to share happenings in our dioceses, to hear updates on national plans and to spend time in prayer and fellowship.

I remind you all of our 2025 theme: Forward into the future: with hope and love, and our 2025 theme song *God Gives Us a Future.*
